Each child took turn standing in front of their classmates to share the stories behind their family photos. It was inspiring to see their confidence grow as they spoke about their loved ones.

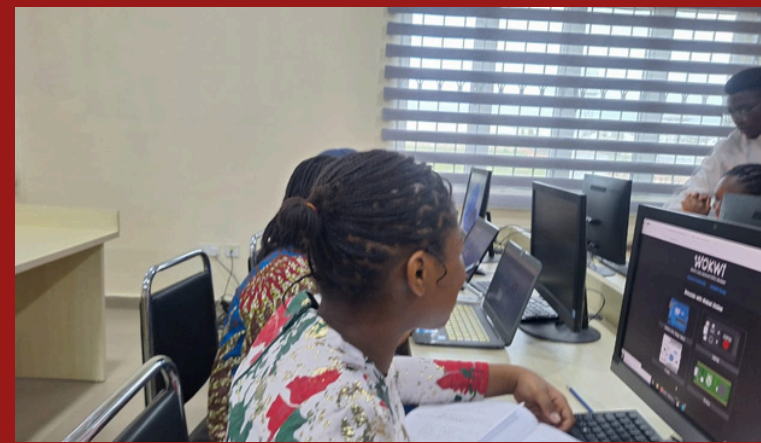
