Our excursion to the Federal Fire Service, along with the school-wide fire drill,

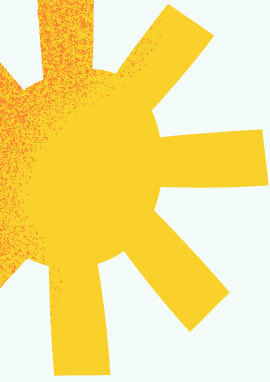


provided practical lessons in safety and emergency preparedness.

EARLY YEARS



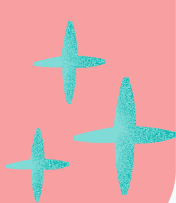
February Highlights

We also held our Parents' Consultation sessions, which provided a valuable opportunity for meaningful discussions on students' academic progress and overall development.

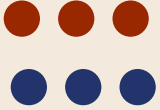

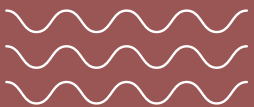
